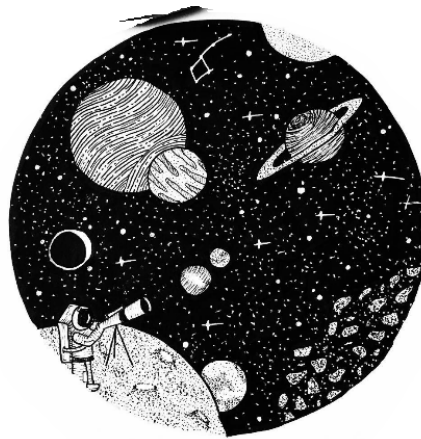


HAIKU

Space! So much to see.

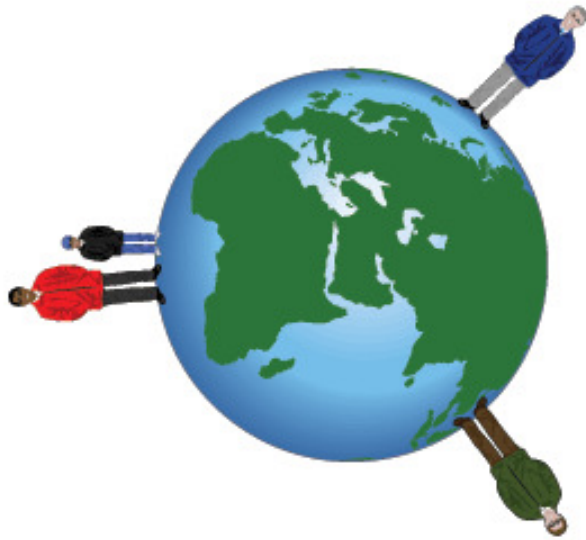
Thanks NASA for helping me

Right in front of you.

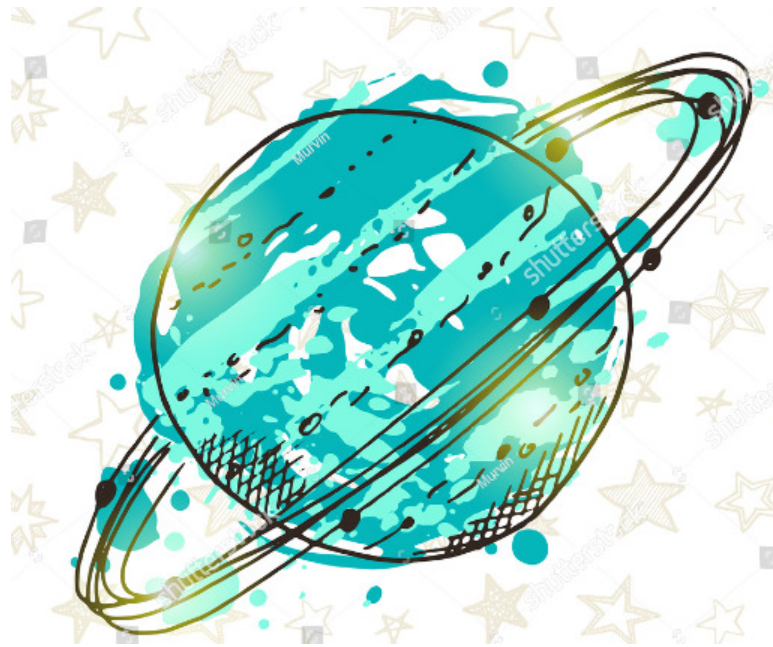


Like Jupiter flies

Only stars can shine light.



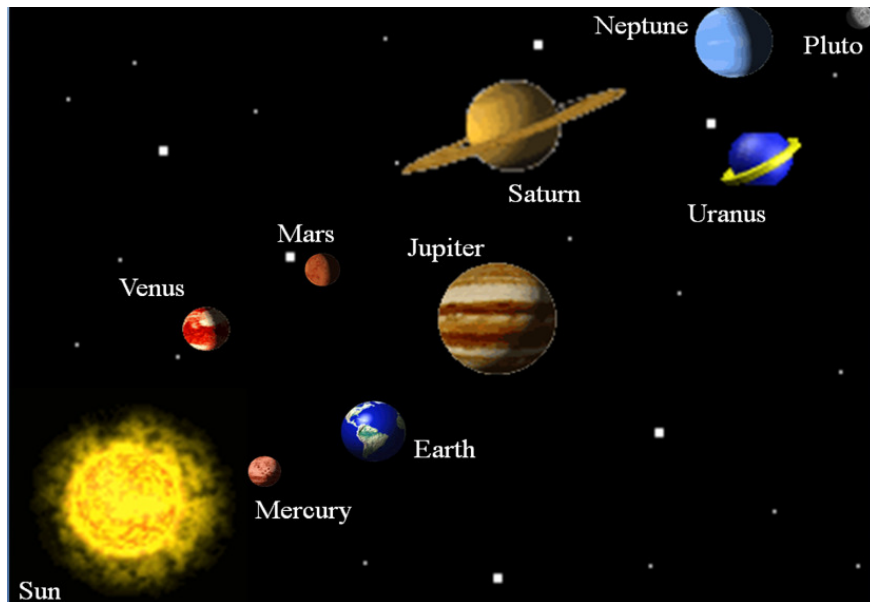
Big space telescope

Holding space above.



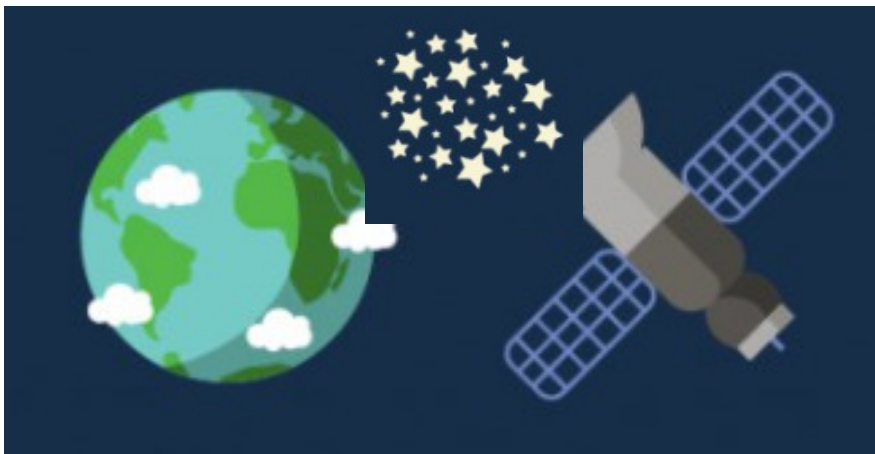
They remind me of

Raindrops everywhere.



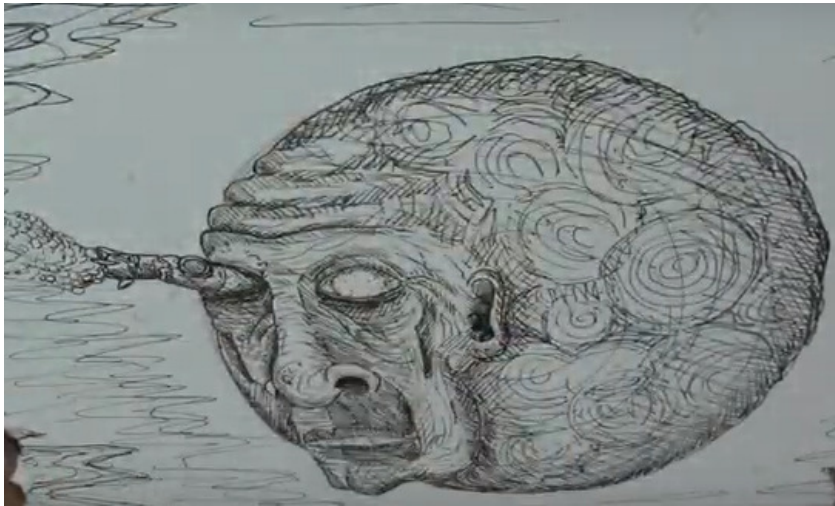
I dream about the moon

Aim for the stars and dream big

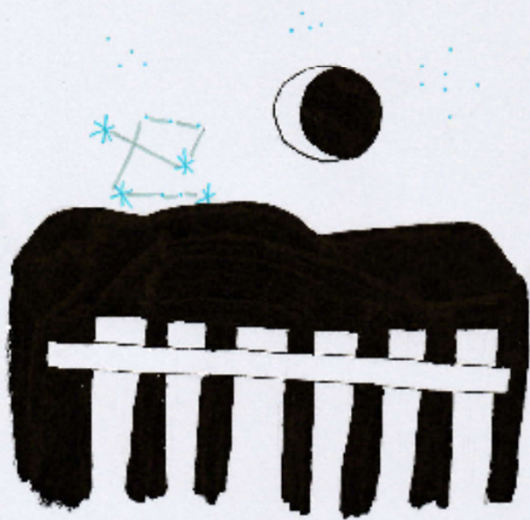

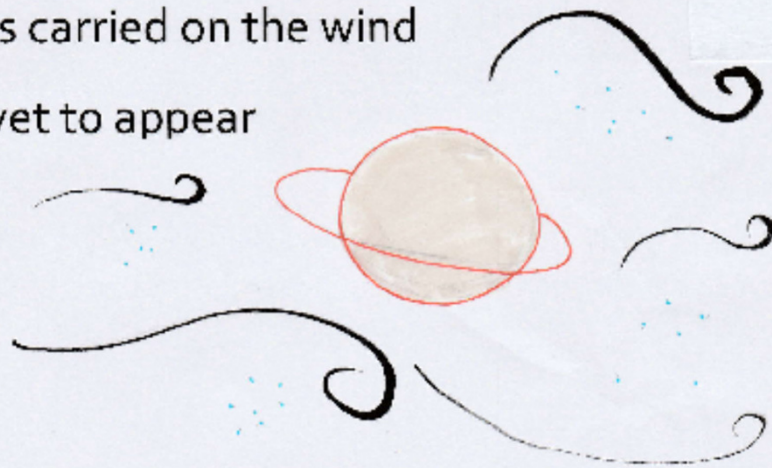
Ana Faria

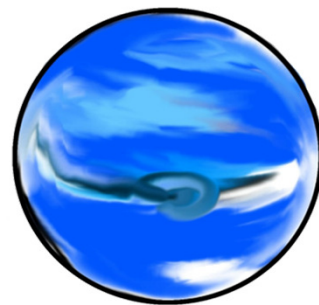
Pluto the planet
